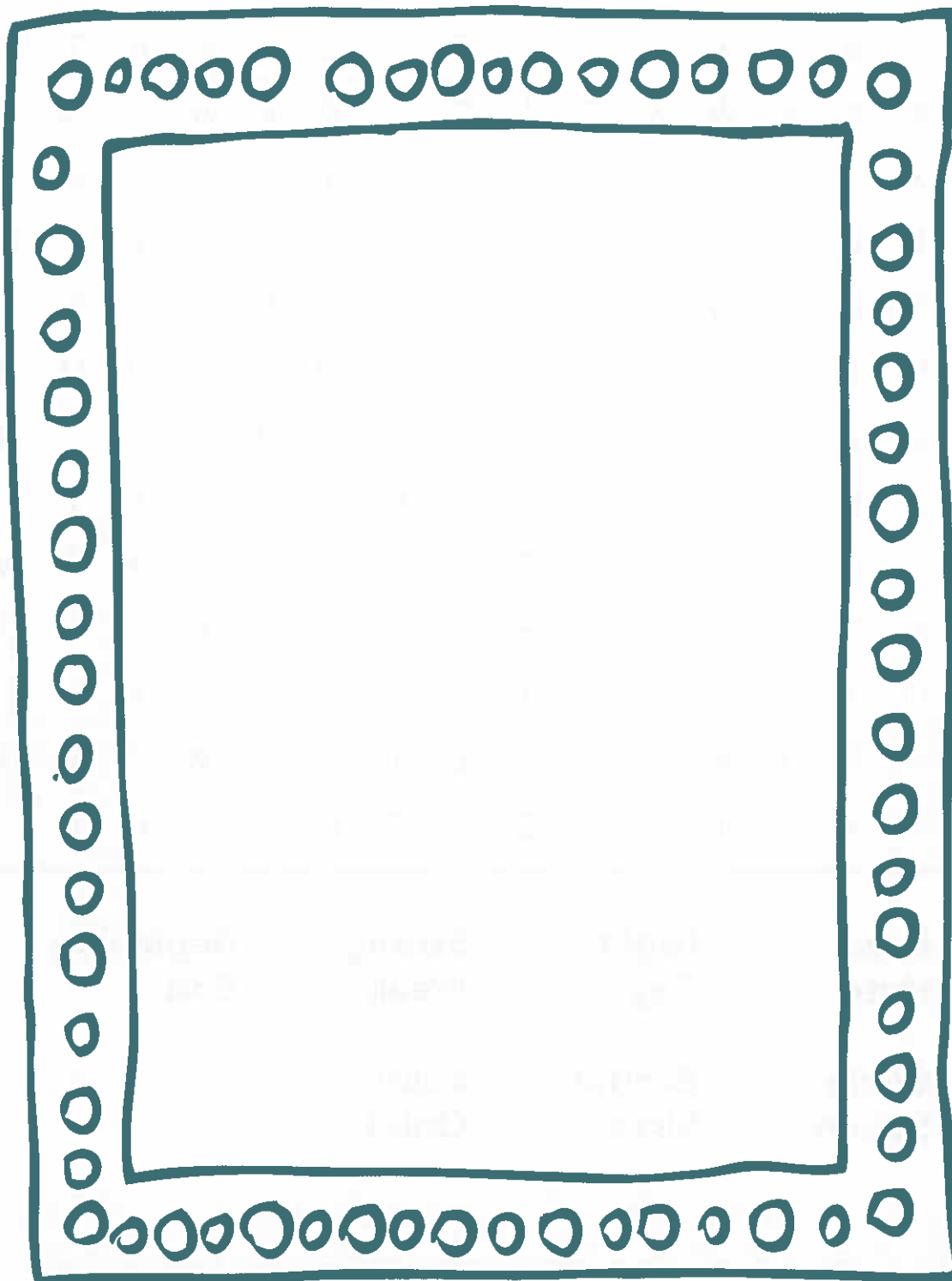

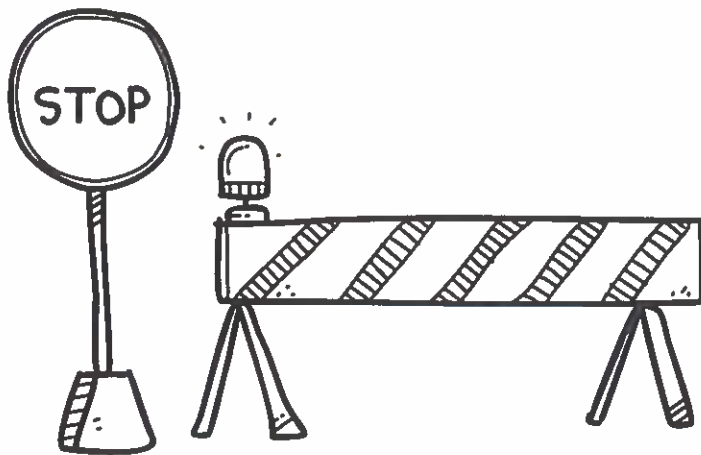

Esau made a hard and fast decision because he was really hungry. But, I wonder what might have happened if Esau had stopped and talked to God?

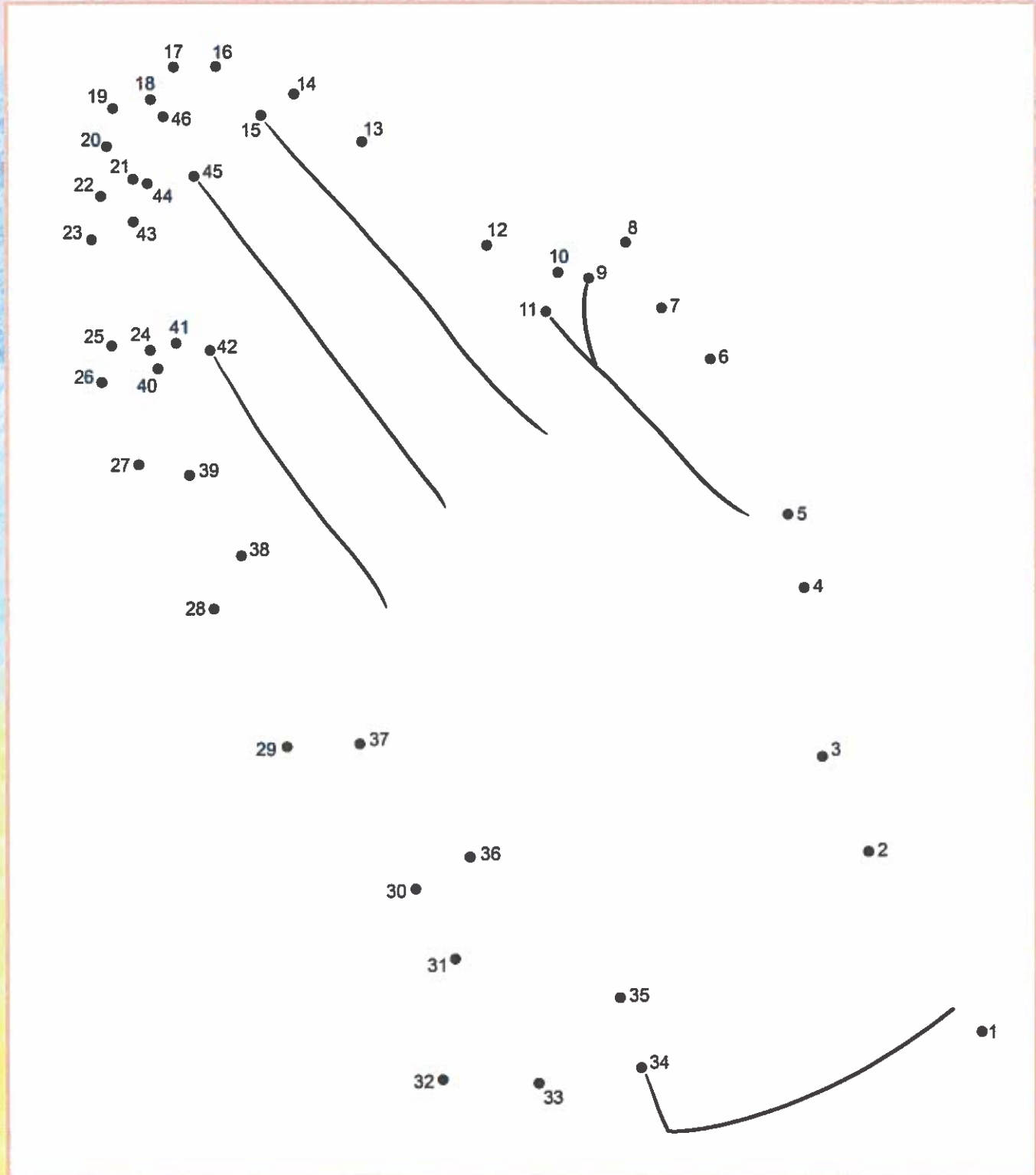

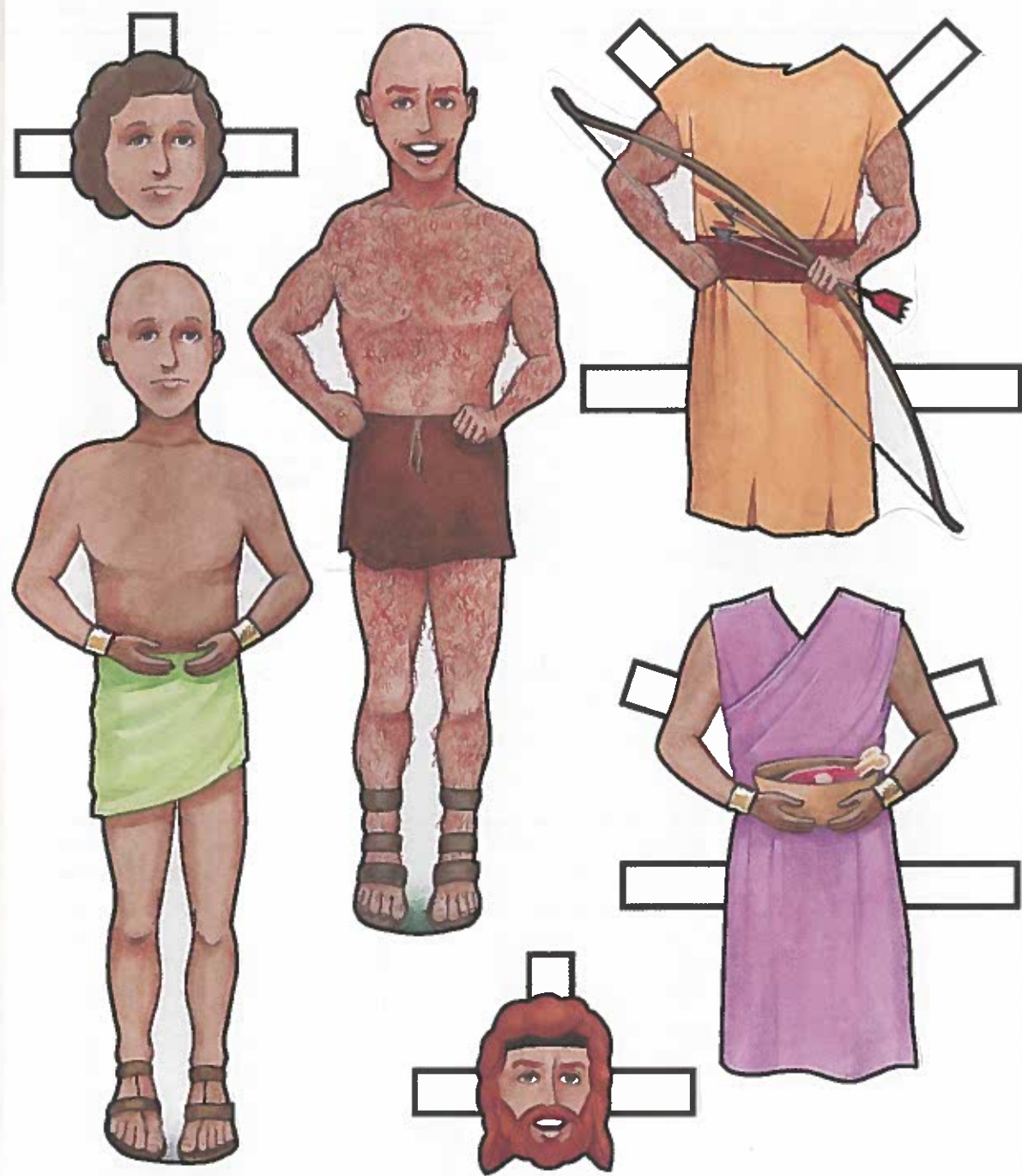

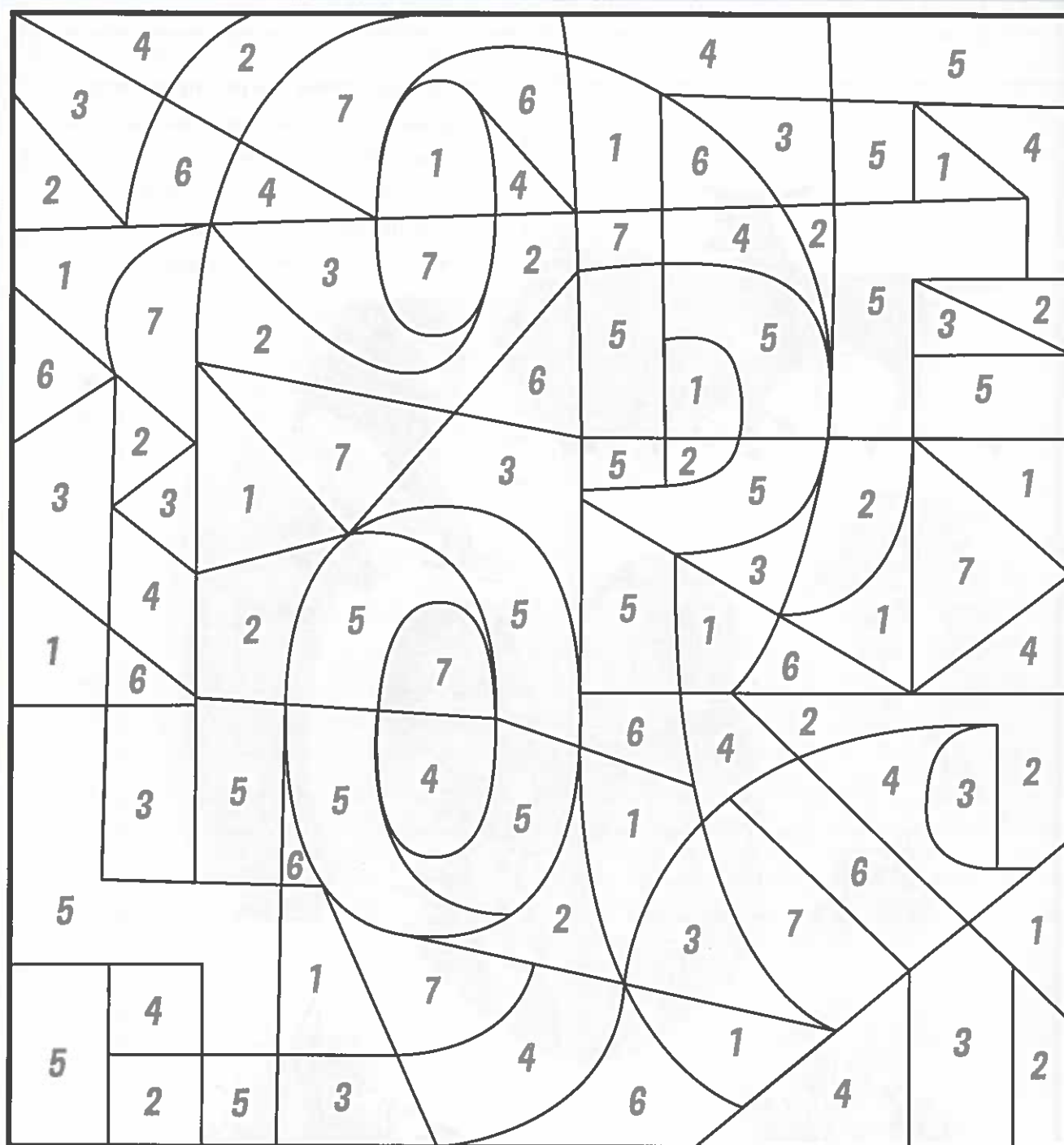

Food Chain

A **food chain** is the connection between **plants** and **animals**. Food chains are connected like a circle or a web because each part needs another part to survive. The food chain is a system that shows how certain plants and animals live and consume their food.

In food chains there are **producers** and **consumers**. Plants are producers because they create food for other living things. A consumer uses the food for energy. Animals that eat other animals are called **secondary consumer** or **predators**.



When animals die, they decompose and become nutrients for the earth to grow more plants.
